Next Steps: We discover the 1st Compass Point of God's will in the words of Jesus recorded in John 6:40, "My Father's will is that everyone who looks to the Son and believes in Him shall have eternal life, and I will raise them up at the last day."

The 2nd Compass Point of God's will is found in 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 as Paul writes, "Rejoice always, pray continually, give thanks in all circumstances; for <u>this is</u> God's will for you in Christ Jesus."

Rejoice Always: How do the following Scriptures help us reorient our lives toward being "Joy-Filled" people?

Read 1 Chronicles 15:7-36

Read Philippians 1-4

Read Romans 5:1-8

Pray Continually: Read <u>"The Practice of the Presence of God"</u> by Brother Lawrence. Begin to implement what you have learned into your daily life.

Give Thanks In All Circumstances: Paul commands us to "give thanks <u>in</u> all circumstances" not "<u>for</u> all circumstances." What is the difference between these two prepositions?

Make a list of your circumstances you are having a hard time "giving thanks in."

Read Romans 8:28. What two things must be in place for us to be confident "that <u>in</u> all things God works for the good"? How are you doing with these two things?

How does this verse relate to the first two compass points?

Next Week: We will be looking at the third compass point of God's will for our lives found in 1 Peter 2:13-15.
