Next Steps: It is reassuring that God has created us on purpose and that has designed each of us for purpose. However, talking about "purpose" can be a rather daunting subject that we approach with fear and trepidation. Spend some time this next week praying for guidance, as you look at these various passages from the Bible.

What do you learn about love from these passages?

- Matthew 22:35-40
- Romans 13:8-10
- Galatians 5:13-14
- 1 Corinthians 13
- 1 Peter 4:8

What does David praise God for in 1 Chronicles 16:7-36?

What work did Jesus finish in John 17:1-5? How did this bring glory to God the Father?

Read Ephesians 2:1-10. Thinks about your life in terms of what it was like before met Jesus (2:1-3) and how you came to understand Jesus as Savior (2:4-9) and what your response should be now (2:10).
