Next Steps:

Read through Isaiah 6:1-8. In this passage Isaiah remembers a very powerful vision that changed his life.

Why is the angels' threefold repetition of the word "holy" so important as a description of God's nature?

How did Isaiah react to this vision?

Rewrite Isaiah 6:5 in your own words.

How did God solve Isaiah's problem? (Isaiah 6:6-7)

How do you think this prepared Isaiah to volunteer for the mission God had for his life?

Read Romans 3:21-26. How does this passage compare to the Isaiah 6:1-8 passage?

Read 1 John 1:5-10. What word is used to describe God? Who & what purifies us from our sin? When we recognize we have sinned, what is our responsibility and what is God's promise (1 John 1:9)?

Read 2 Corinthians 5:21. What does Jesus become for us? What do we become in light of the work of Jesus?

Spend some time in prayer praising God for who He is and thanking Him for what He has done. When we see a clearer picture of God's holy nature, we will also see our sin more clearly. Spend a few minutes asking God to forgive your sins. Now sit still and "listen" for God's voice? What is God asking you to do? Are you willing to respond like Isaiah? If so, ask God to give you strength and courage do what He created you to do.

Next Week: Next week we will be looking at the life of Abram (Abraham) as he discerned his purpose and then lived into his purpose. His story can be found in the book of Genesis, chapters 12-25.
