



# BAJA BOUND

Building homes for the working poor of Mexico

## THE GENERAL ITINERARY:

### Friday, February 15th

- 7:00am – Meet up with Baja Bound staff, cross the border and drive to Ensenada
- 10:30am – Worksite to begin house building (lunch at the worksite)
- 6:00pm – Head to the beach house for dinner, orientation, free time

### Saturday, February 16th

- 7:00 am – Breakfast at the Beach House
- 8:00am – Construction/Visit to Aqua Vida Community Center & feeding program (lunch at the worksite)
- 6:00pm – Dinner at Tacos El Poblanos
- 7:00pm – Beach House - free time

### Sunday, February 17th

- 7:00am – Breakfast
- 8:00am – Beachside Church Service
- 9:00am – Construction
- Noon – Lunch at worksite
- 3:00pm – House Dedication & Depart for the Border

## THE DETAILS:

**Transportation** - We will caravan and have one of the Baja Bound staff persons with us for the drive to and from Ensenada. We will be taking the church van, but will need others to drive as well. All vehicles need to have vehicle insurance that protects them in Mexico. (policies for the weekend can be purchased for about \$40.00)

**Cost** - The cost is \$125.00 per person (financial help is available if needed). This fee takes care of housing, food & staffing for our time. A member of the Baja Bound staff will be with us at all times. We have received enough in donations to cover the cost of the home (\$7,000) so participants are only having to cover their participation fee!

**Equipment** - Baja Bound provides all the tools needed and will have plenty of bottled water on hand during the day

**Waiver** - Each participant needs to complete an online waiver form (links on the Baja Bound website: [www.bajabound.org](http://www.bajabound.org))

**Documentation** - The best form of documentation is a valid passport. However, you can also use a certified birth certificate and photo ID.

**Housing** - The Baja Bound “Beach House” is a wonderful multi-room home with plenty of space to spread out. There is a common meeting/eating area and indoor plumbing. There will be linens on the beds, but it can get chilly at night this time of year so a sleeping bag is recommended. Families and married couples can have their own rooms.
