Listed below are a few items of importance that will make the camp experience more enjoyable!

- Sleeping bag and pillow
- Flashlight
- Warm clothes – It has been a very dry winter so far up there so at this point there isn't any snow on the ground. The forecast is for high 50's during the day and 30's at night.
- Toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, deodorant, etc.)
- Towel
- Pajamas
- Shoes you can be active in – 2 pairs are recommended just in case one gets wet/muddy somehow
- Medication – if you have a prescription drug you take, bring it in the original container; the camp medical/health person will be holding it for the weekend and getting it to you as prescribed
 - All over the counter medication also has to be turned in to the health care provider
- **Bible, pen (if you don't have a Bible we'll have extras)**
- Optional Spending money:
 - For Snacks or the gift shop; we'll make a pit stop at a fast food restaurant on the way up and back

Things to **NOT** bring to camp:

- Cell phones – while we are at camp we will ask that you not be stuck on your phone; we know you use it for pictures, music and alarms, but we want you to be engaged with the people you are at camp with
- Drugs, alcohol, etc.
- Anything that can create a mess (i.e. – silly string, etc.)
- Anything that could be of great loss, if it were to be broken or misplaced – they have lockers you can bring a lock for if there is something you NEED to bring
