Next Steps: Too often during this time of the year we can be overwhelmed by the time-consuming trappings of the holidays. As a result, we don't take the time to prepare our hearts for The Advent of Jesus. This is our opportunity to personally reflect on God's great gift to the world in the miraculous birth of Jesus.

Read Romans 5:1-11

What do these verses teach you about your "high favor" in God's eyes?
