Is there a wrong way to pray?

Confess

We all make mistakes (maybe it was a lie or yelling at your sibling or not listening to your parents). God already knows we did it. But when we come to God and tell him about it and ask for forgiveness it shows that we trust God and know know that He loves us no matter what. It also brings us closer to God.

Honor

God loves to hear our worship. Tell God how awesome He is. Tell Him how amazing His creation is. When we honor God it also reminds us of all He has done and all He continues to do. It reminds us how big God is!

Ask

God says we can ask for anything in His name. We can ask for wisdom, help, healing, comfort, boldness. We can ask for those things not only for ourselves but for others too.

Thank

Take some time to say thank you to God. Be specific. What are you thankful for?
