## **Next Steps For Next Week:**

**Monday:** Read Psalm 100 What are some of the "action verbs" the Psalmist uses to describe your thanksgiving? What "reasons" does the Psalmist use to describe why God should be the object of your gratitude?

**Tuesday:** Read Genesis 1-2 & 1 Timothy 4:1-5 How is God's creation described in these passages? How do you feel about God's creation today? What does the Apostle Paul say to Timothy about how we should receive and interact with God's creation?

**Wednesday:** Read Philippians 4:10-20 How does God provide for the Apostle Paul? What promise does Paul make about God meeting your needs? List 10 ways God met your needs and spend time thanking God for His faithfulness.

**Thursday:** Read Psalm 86:8-12 out loud before your Thanksgiving meal How do the words of this Psalm inspire your worship, inform your thankfulness and motivate your commitment?

**Friday:** Read Joshua 23 Joshua was chosen to lead the people of God to take possession of the "Promised Land." Now Joshua is on the precipice of his own death. What does Joshua want God's people to remember?

**Saturday:** Read 2 Corinthians 1:18-22 How many promises has God made? Why can you be assured that God will be faithful to fulfill all of His promises? What are some of the promises listed in these verses for which you can be thankful?

**Sunday:** Read John 1:1-18 Today is the first Sunday of Advent. This is the beginning of our time of preparation to celebrate the birth of Jesus. How is Jesus described in this passage? How does this description of Jesus inspire you to be thankful?
