**Next Steps For Next Week:**

Read Mark 3:13-19            Write down the names of the original 12 Apostles. What “authority” did Jesus give to them?

Read Acts 1:12-26            After the betrayal and death of Judas Iscariot, the followers of Jesus felt it necessary to choose a “replacement Apostle.” How many people were in the room? What were all of them doing? What were the “qualifications” for the new “Apostle?” How was the choice made?

Read Acts 2:42-47            The early church was “devoted to the apostles’ teaching.” How did they express this devotion? What were the results?

Read Acts 9:1-30            This is the story of Saul’s conversion from “breathing out murderous threats” to placing his faith in Jesus as the Messiah. How did God get Saul’s attention? What did Saul do when he arrived in Damascus? What challenges did Saul face?

Read 1 Corinthians 15:1-11    What is the message of “the Gospel?” Why does Paul have a humble opinion of himself as an “apostle?”

Read Ephesians 2:1-10            How are we made “alive in Christ?”

Ephesians 2:11-22            What is the promise given to those who believe in this Gospel?
