Next Steps For Next Week:

Read Ephesians 1:1-14 - Spend some time looking at this passage again and discovering more about “The Gospel Truth.” What do you need to embrace this week to be more fully living into The Gospel Truth? Why?

Read Ephesians 1:15-23 - Look at the rest of Ephesians 1. What is Paul’s prayer for you? What is God’s “incomparably great power?” According to these verse, who is the head of “the church?”

Read Titus 3:1-7 - How should “The Gospel Truth” be manifest in and through our lives. What is the promise given to those who have been justified by God’s Grace?

Read Romans 5:1-11 - Most of “boasting” is strongly discouraged in the Bible. But in this passage what/whom does Paul say we should “boast in” or “glory in?”

Read Colossians 1:15-23 - What is “the hope held out in the Gospel?” How can you help others to understand this “Good News?”

Read Hebrews 10:19-25 - In whom should we put our confidence? What are some things we should be doing to “hold unswervingly to the hope we profess?”

Read 1 Peter 1:1-12 - What is “the end result of your faith?” Have you put your trust in Jesus? If not, please spend some time in prayer: confessing your sin, thanking Jesus for dying on the cross for your sin, and asking Jesus to fill you with inexpressible and glorious joy.
