Next Steps For Next Week:

Read 2 Timothy 3:1-9 - Spend some time looking at these. What “terrible times” is Paul describing? What rings true for our day and age? What “terrible times” are you experiencing?

Read 2 Timothy 3:10-17 - How did Paul compare his teaching to that of “Jannes & Jambres?” What do you learn from the “Holy Scriptures?” What other benefits do you receive?

Read 2 Peter 1:16-21 - What do these verses teach you about the trustworthiness of the Bible?

Read Matthew 17:1-13 - Peter referred back to this experience when he wrote 2 Peter 1:16-21. How does this experience help you to believe the reliability of the Bible? How can reflecting back on your own “God experiences” strengthen your faith?

Read Hebrews 4:12 & John 1:1-14 - How do these passages show you the relevancy of God’s Word for today... even though it was written thousands of years ago?

Read Romans 12:1-2 & Isaiah 55:10-11 - “The Word of God has the power to change everything!” Do you believe this statement to be true? How have you been “transformed by the renewing of your mind?” What are some steps you can take to be more consistent in “renewing your mind?”

Read Hebrews 1:1-3 - How did God speak in the past? How did God speak in the first century? How does God speak to you today?
