Next Steps For Next Week:

Read 1 Corinthians 10:23-11:1 What is the context for Paul’s words, “Do it all for the glory of God” in verse 31? Are there areas in your life where you demand your “rights” over “God’s glory” and/or your “neighbor’s good?”

Read Matthew 22:34-40 Who was trying to “test” Jesus? How does Jesus respond to this test? How do you love God with all your heart, soul and mind? Can you love your neighbor well if you don’t love yourself well?

Read Luke 10:25-37 Luke records Jesus said the Greatest Commandment includes loving God “with all your strength.” How do you love God with your “strength?” Luke also says we must “Love our neighbor as yourself.” But then the expert in the law asks, “Who is my neighbor?” Jesus responds by sharing a story about a Good Samaritan. Who are the people who “passed by the injured man?” Who is the “neighbor” or the “hero” in this story? What is Jesus telling the “expert in the law” to do? How hard would it be for this Jewish Religious leader to “act like this Samaritan?”

Read Matthew 28:16-20 This passage is commonly referred to as “The Great Commission.” Why do you think it has earned this name? What are the things we should be doing to be involved in the Great Commission? How are you personally helping to fulfill the Great Commission?

Read Genesis 12:1-3 The Great Commission was God’s plan from the beginning. How does God’s promise to Abram shine a spot light on the Great Commission?

Read Acts 1:1-11 Where is does the power come from to fulfill the Great Commission? What is the scope of the Great Commission?”

Read Revelation 5:1-14 The Apostle John has a vision of the future. How many tribes, languages, people and nations are worshipping? What are the words everyone is saying to Jesus, the Lamb of God?
