Read John 3:1-17 Why do you think Nicodemus came to Jesus "at night?" What did Nicodemus "know" about Jesus? What do you "know" about Jesus? What questions do you have for Him?

Read John 3:1-17 again Have you "believed" in Jesus? If not, what is holding you back? What promise does Jesus make for all who "believe" in Him?

Read 2 Peter 2:1-12 Spiritual growth involves getting rid of some things and embracing other things? What are some things you need to get rid of so you can grow? What do you need to do to embrace the good things? What does it mean to be a "living stone?" What is the result of living a "good life?"

Read 1 John 5:1-15 John makes it very clear that those who believe "that Jesus is the Christ" are born again. What does it mean, "to believe?"

Read Ephesians 1:1-14 What is our "inheritance?" How does the Holy Spirit guarantee this "inheritance?"
