Review the "BLESS" inserts found in your bulletin. (If you don't have one, you can find them in the lobby or contact the office and we will send you one.) Begin praying and asking God to reveal the people in your life that are far from God. Write down their names on the two "bookmarks." Use one bookmark as your reminder to pray daily for each of these people. Return the other bookmark to the church so we can pray with you. Ask God to give you opportunities to bless them in some way as you listen to their stories and meet their needs.

Luke 4:16-21- Why did Jesus choose this passage from Isaiah 61:1-2 to read in the synagogue? What has Jesus been "anointed" to do? How can you help fulfill Jesus' mission?

Luke 5:27-32 - Why did Jesus eat with the tax collectors and "sinners?" How did Jesus answer the complaints of the religious leaders?

Luke 7:18-25 - What did the religious leaders (the Pharisees) think of John the Baptist? What words did these folks use to describe Jesus?

Luke 7:36-50 - Who are the people in your life that need to experience the love and grace of Jesus? What is something you can do this week to help them move one step closer to God? How can you be intentional about inviting him or her out to eat or over to eat... or to get the beverage of your choice?

Luke 10:38-42 - Jesus stopped to eat at Martha's house. What was Martha worried about? What did Mary do? How did Martha respond to Mary? What did Jesus say was most important?

Luke 11:37-54 - Once again we see Jesus at a table. What were the Pharisees (religious leaders) most concerned about? What was Jesus most concerned about? What warnings did Jesus give to those who were righteous in their own eyes?

Luke 14:1-24 - Who were the first people invited to the Banquet? Who do you think they represent? Who were the people invited next? Who do you think they represent? Who are the people God is asking you to invite into His Kingdom?
